



St Andrews Wood is a truly beautiful oak woodland, rich in character and set within the rolling open countryside of Wiltshire. Peaceful, private and full of natural charm, it offers an idyllic escape from the pace of everyday life.

The main entrance is located just inside the shared access gate, where there is ample parking. From here, a woodland path winds gently past a picturesque pond before leading to a well-established camp area with a timber shelter—an inviting space to relax and immerse yourself in the tranquillity of the woodland. Positioned to face west across open fields, the shelter enjoys warm afternoon light, while spectacular sunsets filter through the high oak canopy and illuminate the woodland's western edge.

The woodland floor is predominantly flat, making it easy to explore throughout the seasons. During the summer months, grasses and wildflowers flourish beneath the trees, adding to the woodland's natural beauty.

Veteran oak dominate the landscape and also line the impressive rides that run south and east around the site. A diverse mix of willow, hawthorn, field maple, ash and young hazel are also present.

Far removed from busy roads, St Andrews Wood offers complete peace and seclusion. Wildlife is abundant, with hares, deer, tawny owls, barn owls and even a party of peacocks regularly seen amongst the trees.

For anyone dreaming of owning their own woodland, St Andrews Wood presents a rare opportunity to enjoy an enchanting natural setting.

The picturesque town of Cricklade is just a short drive away, with a range of pubs, shops and restaurants. Blunsdon and Swindon are also within easy reach, providing convenient access to the M4.

The ward is Blunsdon and Highworth and the Council is Swindon Borough.

Boundaries: The boundary is open on all sides and borders neighbouring woodland N and fields W. SE follows the drainage ditch and the bridleway beyond, S and E follow the main access track. The boundaries are also marked with blue paint on trees and posts.

Access: There is excellent vehicle access all year round via a hard track and locked posts at the junction of Little Rose Lane and a shared gate leading into the wood itself. There is a large parking area next to the main entrance to St Andrews Wood.

Covenant: There is a covenant on the wood designed to ensure the quiet and peaceful enjoyment of this and adjoining woodlands, click [HERE](#) to read and download.

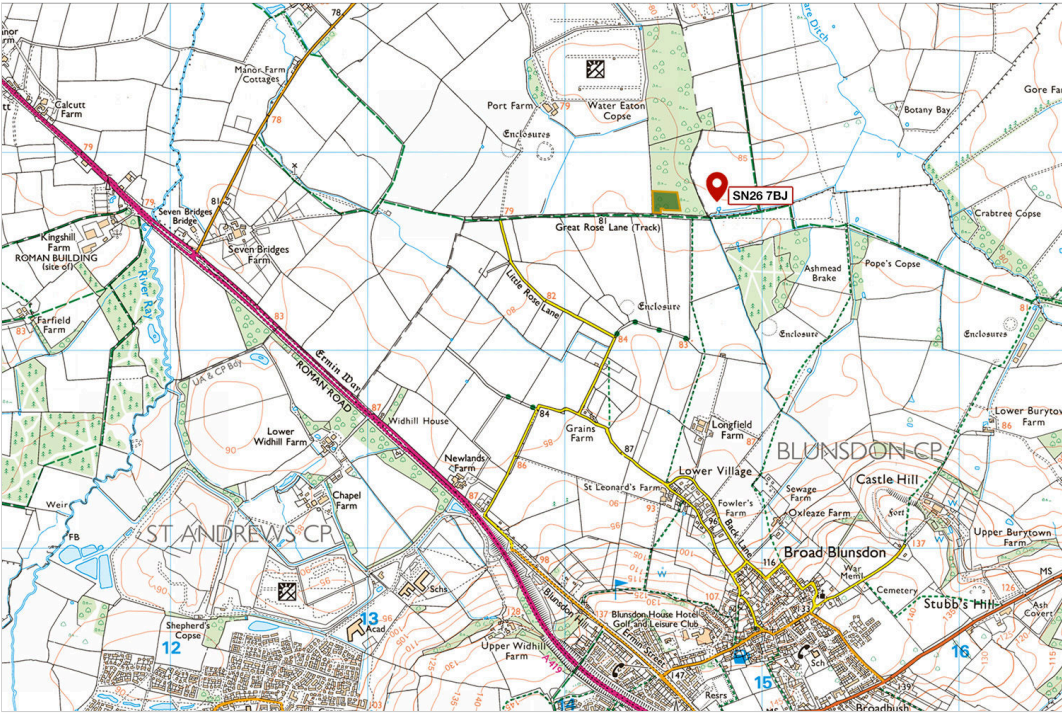

St Andrews Wood, Great Rose Lane, Broad Blunsdon, Swindon.

1. [Click here for Bing Maps Directions](#) click on the "Directions" box and enter your own postcode.

- For viewing purposes, park at the end of Little Rose Lane as marked on the map. Please don't block the access.
- Follow the track marked blue for approx 800m. The main entrance will be on your left. Carefully climb over the gate to enter the woodland.
- Once over the gate, the entrance to St Andrews Wood will be on you left.
